BOOK FAIR

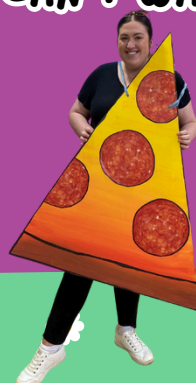
